

## **One Day Sewing Courses**

We provide tea / coffee with biscuits and a lovely two course lunch. Our one day sewing courses include all materials & equipment unless otherwise stated in the course details. Courses usually start at 10.00am and finish at approximately 4.00pm

#### 10<sup>th</sup> May Thursday Beginners Patchwork

This course is designed for you to learn the basics of patchwork, to include choosing colours and prints for different patchwork designs and to see the most interesting effects. You will learn how to cut, pin and sew pieces together using appropriate equipment safely and accurately. You will make different patchwork blocks with matching seams and points that you can build on.

## 17<sup>th</sup> May Friday Dressmaking Tips for Beginners

Would you like a helping hand understanding the basics of dressmaking? This course will cover the techniques of cutting and pinning your pattern and fabric, finishing edges and seams, sewing darts, inserting zips, along with understanding dressmaking patterns and terminology used.

## 24<sup>th</sup> May Friday Know Your Overlocker

Do you have an overlocker and lack confidence using the machine? We will show you how simple and easy it is to use. This course will build your confidence to tackle many overlocking techniques. This course is taught by an overlocker specialist. Please note you need to bring your overlocker with you and it must be in working order. This course starts at 10.00am and finishes at 3.30pm.

## 7<sup>th</sup> June Friday Beginners Pattern Cutting

Tired of finding ill-fitting clothes and want to learn how to make a garment which is a perfect fit? Draft out your personal skirt block from your own body measurements and learn how to construct the toile and any fitting techniques required. It's amazing what you can do with a pencil and paper.

#### 14<sup>th</sup> June Friday Jelly Roll Quilt

Come and try this unique technique to make a lap quilt using a jelly roll and a sewing machine. If you like random designs and colours then this is perfect for you to make for yourself or as a gift. The lap quilt will have a soft feel back, making it great to snuggle up in. Anyone can make this quilt. There is no right or wrong way to the design.

#### Date to be arranged Download and Embroider Project

Do you own an embroidery machine? Would you like to take home an embroidered project? Would you like to download an embroidery design in the correct file format from a website – but are a little nervous of, or daunted by your new machine? Then this is the course for you. ## 28<sup>th</sup> June Friday

#### **Liberty Drawstring Skirt**

This is the perfect easy-to-wear skirt for those lazy summer days. Easy to sew with a sewing machine and overlocker, this stylish skirt with optional side splits and a drawstring waist, all made in Liberty cotton fabric, will look great for any occasion.

## 8<sup>th</sup> August Thursday Know Your Sewing Machine (Computerized)

You will learn how to use the different stitches on your machine, how to combine stitches and save them into the memories of your machine. We will show you how to use the different accessory feet that came with your machine, along with some extra ones. You will stitch samples to refer to, covering dressmaking, embellishment, patchwork and quilting. Please note you will need to bring your machine and accessories with you. This course is taught by a sewing machine specialist.

## 9<sup>th</sup> August Friday Know Your Embroidery Unit

This is a follow on course to the one above. Once you have learnt how to use the sewing functions of your machine, we will show you how to use your embroidery unit. We will cover embroidery placement, combining designs within your machine's capabilities along with rotation, mirroring, sizing and duplication. You will use different fabrics, stabilizers, threads and needles. Please note you will need to bring your sewing machine and embroidery unit with you. This course is taught by a sewing machine specialist. This course starts at 9.30am and finishes at 3.30pm.

#### **Know Your Sewing Machine**

## 16<sup>th</sup> April Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> June Tuesday

Whether your machine is very basic with just a few stitches or has up to 50, then this is the course for you.
