One Day Sewing Courses

We provide tea / coffee with biscuits and a lovely two course lunch. Our one day sewing courses include all materials & equipment unless otherwise stated in the course details. Courses usually start at 10.00am and finish at approximately 4.00pm unless otherwise stated in the course description.

15th January Wednesday Soft Furnishings Stage 1 (Curtains)

Understand how to evaluate and measure for dressing a window. Then learn how to calculate fabric and haberdashery quantities for your curtains. Finally you will construct a sample lined curtain with a pencil pleat heading. All abilities welcome. You don't need to be a mathematician or a brilliant sewer. This class starts at 9.30pm and finishes at 3.30pm. This one day class is £100.

17th January Friday Dressmaking Tips for Beginners

Would you like a helping hand understanding the basics of dressmaking? This course will cover the techniques of cutting and pinning your pattern and fabric, finishing edges and seams, sewing darts, inserting zips, along with understanding dressmaking patterns and terminology used. This one day course is £95.

24th January Friday Know Your Sewing Machine (Computerised)

You will learn how to use the different stitches on your machine, how to combine stitches and save them into the memories of your machine. We will show you how to use the different accessory feet that came with your machine, along with some extra ones. You will stitch samples to refer to, covering dressmaking, embellishment, patchwork and quilting. Please note you will need to bring your machine and accessories with you. This course is taught by a sewing machine specialist. This one day course is $\pounds 100$.

25th January Saturday Know Your Embroidery Unit

This is a follow on course to the one above. Once you have learnt how to use the sewing functions of your machine, we will show you how to use your embroidery unit. We will cover embroidery placement, combining designs within your machine's capabilities along with rotation, mirroring, sizing and duplication. You will use different fabrics, stabilizers, threads and needles. Please note you will need to bring your sewing machine and embroidery unit with you. This course is taught by a sewing machine specialist. This course starts at 9.30am and finishes at 3.30pm. This one day course is £100. You can pay for this course and the above course at a discounted rate of £190.00.

31st January Friday Beginners Pattern Cutting

Tired of finding ill-fitting clothes and want to learn how to make a garment which is a perfect fit? Draft out your personal skirt block from your own body measurements and learn how to construct the toile and any fitting techniques required. It's amazing what you can do with a pencil and paper. This one day course is £95.

5th February Wednesday Know Your Overlocker

Do you have an overlocker and lack confidence using the machine? We will show you how simple and easy it is to use. This course will build your confidence to tackle many overlocking techniques. This course is taught by an overlocker specialist. Please note you need to bring your overlocker with you and it must be in working order. This course starts at 10.00am and finishes at 3.30pm. This one day course is £100.

Half Day Sewing Courses

Know Your Sewing Machine

29th January Wednesday

We will show you how to use your own sewing machine. Any brand of machine is welcome on this course. Whether your machine is very basic with just a few stitches or has up to 50, then this is the course for you. Learning how to thread your sewing machine is just the start of your learning possibilities. (Please bring your sewing machine with you, materials are provided). If your machine has more stitches and buttons, then you can learn much more on our one day Know Your Sewing Machine course. These half day courses are £55 each.

Simple Skirt

18th January Saturday

Come along and see how to sew a simple drawstring skirt using a sewing machine and an overlocker. This skirt can be made in a variety of different fabrics for an occasion. Learn to use a sewing machine and explore an overlocker. We will provide fabrics and machines for you to use on this course. This course is £55 each.

Weekly Sewing Courses

We will provide the sewing machines & equipment along with tea / coffee and biscuits. Each student will need to provide materials and other notions to make their projects. These must be purchased in the shop before the course starts. Some of the courses have a set project to get you started. You will learn at your own pace and sew what you like within your growing capabilities.

28th December Saturday

On this course, your child will be shown how to use a sewing machine safely. Starting with learning how to thread the machine correctly, they will then be shown how to hold and guide the fabric through the machine to sew a straight line of stitching as well as learning about the correct use of stitches when finishing the edges of the fabric. We will also cover the different features of the machine and what they would be used for when sewing. The main emphasis of the course will be the safe use of the machine. You are welcome to bring your sewing machine with you to this course. All materials are included. Each course is £50.
