

One Day Sewing Courses

All one day sewing courses include all materials & equipment. We also provide tea / coffee with biscuits and a lovely two course lunch. Courses start at 10.00am and finish at approximately 4.00pm unless otherwise stated in the course details.

18th December Monday PE Design Software for Beginners

Would you like to create your own personalized embroidery motifs and don't know where to start? Then this is the course for you. You will be shown how to use the Brother PE Design Software to create embroidery designs. We will teach you how to navigate the program with ease and to use some of the tools within the software. This course is aimed at beginners and other level of courses will follow in the near future. This course starts at 9.30am and finishes at 3.30pm. This one day course is £100. Please bring your laptop and software with you.

19th December Tuesday Know Your Sewing Machine (Computerized)

You will learn how to use the different stitches on your machine, how to combine stitches and save them into the memories of your machine. We will show you how to use the different accessory feet that came with your machine along with some extra ones. You will stitch samples for you to refer to, covering dressmaking, embellishment, patchwork and quilting. Please note you will need to bring your machine with you and your accessories. This course is taught by a sewing machine specialist. This one day course is £100.

20th December Wednesday Know Your Embroidery Unit

This is a follow on course to the one above. Once you have learnt how to use the sewing functions of your machine, we will show you how to use your embroidery unit. We will cover embroidery placement, combining designs within your machine's capabilities along with rotation, mirroring, sizing and duplication. You will use different fabrics, stabilizers, threads and needles. Please note you will need to bring your sewing machine and embroidery unit with you. This course is taught by a sewing machine specialist. This course starts at 9.30am and finishes at 3.30pm. This one day course is £100 or you can pay for the first and second day at a discounted rate of £190.

28th December Thursday PE Design Software Beyond Beginners

A continuation of skills learned during Part 1, this course will focus on honing skills, creating your own embroidery motifs and using them in your creative projects. Have fun and learn new skills to expand your creative sewing. This course starts at 9.30am and finishes at 3.30pm. This one day course is £100. Please bring your laptop and software with you.

26th January Friday Know Your Overlocker

Do you have an overlocker and lack confidence using the machine? We will show you how simple and easy it is to use. This course will build your confidence to tackle many overlocking techniques. This course is taught by an overlocker specialist. Please note you need to bring your overlocker with you and it must be in working order. This course starts at 10.00am and finishes at 3.30pm. This one day course is £100.

30th January Tuesday Soft Furnishings (Curtains)

Understand how to evaluate and measure for dressing a window. Then learn how to calculate fabric and haberdashery quantities for your curtains. Finally you will construct a sample lined curtain with a pencil pleat heading. All abilities welcome. You don't need to be a mathematician or a brilliant sewer. This one day class is £100.

6th February Tuesday Couture Techniques

This course will cover many useful sewing tips from handling, ironing, cutting, stabilizing & interlining fabrics for jackets & coats. Get an understanding for smooth and textured style fabrics for jackets. Learn the difference in drape and construction between a one pieces, two and three piece sleeve. See how to make your own decorative trims. You will make a sample to take home which will include pattern marking, underling & lining the fabric, invisible darts, construction of seams, the trick to a perfect finished hem allowance, weighted hems and bound buttonholes. All great ideas and techniques for a soft, Chanel inspired, formal cardigan jacket. This one day course is £110.

13th February Tuesday Dressmaking with Jersey Fabrics

We stock a fabulous range of stretch fabrics which can be used for a variety of garments. We are often asked about the different types of jersey fabrics and the suitability for particular garment styles. We have designed a course to explain the mystery of how to handle, pin, cut, stitch and press this type of fabric. During this course you will make a sample top to learn these techniques and much more. This one day course is £100.

27th February Tuesday Creative Patchwork Bag

Join this fun one day course to learn some patchwork techniques while making a useful colourful bag. You will use 100% craft cotton fabric, some wadding and a ½" piecing foot on a sewing machine. This completed project is ideal as a gift for your friends and family. This one day course is £95.

6th March Tuesday Sew A Skirt

Do you wish to start making clothes? Then this is the class for you. You will make a funky skirt during this one day course. Learn the techniques of cutting, pining, overlocking, sewing seams, fastenings and hems. Wear your skirt with pride and say I made it! This one day course is £95.

13th March Tuesday Soft Furnishings (Roman Blinds)

Learn how to calculate and measure quantities of fabric and haberdashery required for a roman blind. This will include understanding the fabric types & designs, along with different types of linings. You will construct a sample roman blind using tapes and cord for you to refer to in the future. This one day course is £100

Half Day Sewing Courses

Decorative Stitching

8th February Thursday

2.00pm - 4.00pm

This short class will show you how to get the best results from a machines range of decorative stitches, while making an heirloom pillow. Come and have a go with a wing needle, Twin needle and lots of different shaped stiches and colours of threads. This course is £45

Trouser Shortening

22nd February Thursday

2.00pm - 3.30pm

Why pay good money to do a small alteration? Please bring a pair of trousers with you to alter. We will show you how to measure the hem, finish the fabric edge and stitch the hem in place securely. You will never need hemming web again! Equipment provided along with tea, coffee & biscuits. All levels of ability are welcome. This course is £32.

Know Your Sewing Machine

20th March Tuesday

10.00am - 1.00pm

We will show you how to use your own sewing machine. Any brand of machine is welcome to this course. Whether your machine is very basic with just a few stitches or has up to 50 stitches, then this is the course for you. Learning how to thread your sewing machine is just the start of your learning possibilities. These individual courses cost £55 each. (Please bring your sewing machine with you, materials are provided). If your machine has more stitches and buttons, then you can learn much more on our one day Know Your Sewing Machine course.

Weekly Sewing Courses

We will provide the sewing machines & equipment along with tea / coffee and biscuits. Each student will need to provide materials and other notions to make their projects. These must be purchased in the shop before the course. Some of the courses have a set project to get you started. You will learn at your own pace and sew what you like within your growing capabilities.

Know Your Sewing Machine!

4th January Thursday 15th February Thursday

9.30am – 12.00pm

On this course, your child will be shown how to use a sewing machine safely. Starting with learning how to thread the machine correctly, they will then be shown how to hold and guide the fabric through the machine to sew a straight line of stitching as well as learning about the correct use of stitches, when finishing the edges of the fabric. We will also cover the different features of the machine and what they would be used for when sewing. The main emphasis of the course will be the safe use of the machine. You are welcome to bring your sewing machine with you to this course, all materials are included. This course is £45.

Tech Bag

Learn how to sew an applique design on a sewing machine while making your very own technology bag, This is perfect to carry your tablets and other electronic devices in and keep safe. This course is £50.
