Applicants are preferred to possess the minimum of Maths & English GCSE or equivalent Grades A to C, as accuracy is essential. We would also encourage applicants who hold some type of textile or fashion design qualification along with computer skills. Applicants who hold a degree or an equivalent qualification in fashion design, tailoring, pattern cutting, soft-

furnishing, or textiles will be able to instruct a weekly sewing course in the subject from the start of their employment after our sewing induction tuition. Other applicants will require training on improving their sewing skills and learning the latest sewing techniques.

Working Times

This position is part-time and requires the applicant to be flexible, also be available to work at short notice and cover for holidays when required. Our normal working hours are as follows. We are open 7 days a week Monday to Saturday 9am to 5.30pm, Sundays 10.30am to 4.30pm. These hours may vary in the future. We open later in the evening for sewing courses and late night for seasonal and Christmas shopping. Please note the position requires longer hours of work during the weeks of exhibitions, events and changes in retail seasons especially on the last day of exhibitions when we have to pack our stand down. Time may be given off in lieu for the extra hours worked or paid at your normal rate of pay depending on the circumstances in the following or previous weeks. Due to Covid-19 our opening hours are subject to change.

Completion

After successful completion of our full interview process the applicant will be offered a part-time position within the company on a 3 month probation (Furloughed time or time off due to temporary business closure or sickness is not included in the 3 month probation period). After 3 months the applicant will be assessed and will either join our team on a permanent basis or will remain on probation for an additional 3 months. There will be much opportunity within the company to learn new skills and work towards additional role positions. Advance Sales Advisor, Senior Demonstrator & Instructor, Embroidery & Software Tutor, Advanced Seamstress, Window Display & Merchandising Supervisor and Website & Social Media Coordinator are just some of the positions you could advance to.
